



Highlights

GLOBAL IMPACT

- Welcomed five new board members, each with a unique perspective and skillset to serve and influence the organization.
- Raised more than \$1.5 million through the Global Impact Ukraine Response Fund, supporting 25 charities whose missions include supporting and responding to worldwide needs.
- Hosted a video series, Philanthropy Insights, featuring honest conversations addressing philanthropic challenges across sectors.
- Generated \$17.01 million for our Charity Alliance partners in public and private sector workplace campaigns.
- Provided critical leadership for the 2021 Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) as the National Marketing Outreach Coordinator, as well as the Outreach Coordinator for CFC local zones.
- Strategic management and fundraising implementation resulted in more than \$54 million raised in monetary and volunteer pledges for CFC charities.
- Together with Geneva Global, launched a new \$5 million resource fund, Vaccine Confident Fund II, to further understand how social media may be leveraged to increase vaccination confidence and uptake.

- Helped multiple generations of a family collectively make grants to leading democracy organizations in the United States.
- Planned and implemented high-level grantee gatherings for family donors.
- Celebrated our Speed School pedagogy becoming part of the core curriculum for teacher training colleges across Ethiopia.
- Supported some of the world's largest private foundations in their efforts to pool and deploy catalytic philanthropic capital.
- Guided CARE teams in two countries in elaborating strategies to achieve full system integration of two of CARE's acclaimed programs to achieve durable impact at scale.
- Built out the absorptive capacity of a leading non-governmental organization in the sustainable apparel sector to capitalize on recent funding infusions.
